# Nature Explorers

Nature Explorers provides Kindergarten, 1st, & 2nd grade students with a hands-on exploration of nature. Each Tuesday afternoon session includes classroom activities on selected topics, outdoor exploration and snack.

Topics Include:

**Tree ID • October 13**

Do you know what kinds of trees grow in River Legacy Parks? Learn to identify trees by examining their bark, leaves and seeds.

**Animal Architects • November 10**

Where and how do River Legacy Parks' animals build their homes? Discover their construction secrets!

**Eye Spy • January 12**

How do animals' eyes differ from human eyes? Investigate the importance of eye position on animals' heads and compare it to the way we use our eyes.

**What's for Dinner? • February 9**

What do animals eat and why? Examine the skulls and jaws of some of River Legacy Parks inhabitants to determine what's on their menu for dinner.

**CSI-RL • March 9**

Who dunnit? Locate and investigate nature's "crime scene" clues to solve some woodland mysteries.

**Animal Chorus • April 13**

Who do you hear and what are they saying? Learn the hows and whys of animal communication.

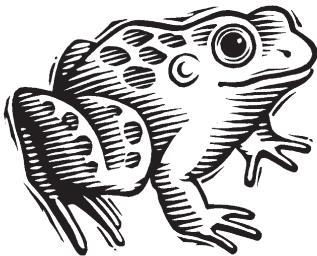
